

Procedures for Tuition Wavers and Cases Requiring Special Treatment

Revised on July 19, 1994

1. Qualifications:
 1. Armed Services Personnel, Civil Servants, Instructors.
 2. Children of current Armed Services Personnel.
 3. Persons with a physical disability.
 4. Children whose parent has a physical disability
 5. Students from low-income families.
 6. Aborigines.
2. Application must be done within two weeks of the start of each semester.
3. Documentation to be submitted depends on how the applicant qualifies. Please note the following:
 1. Armed Services Personnel, Civil Servants, Instructors:
 1. Both Original and Copy of Relief Order or Statement of Yearly Relief.
 2. Notice of Registration and Fee Payment showing record of previous fee payments.
 2. Children of current Armed Services Personnel:
 1. Notice of Registration and Fee Payment showing record of previous fee payments.
 2. Original and copy of Armed Services Identity Card and Certificate of Supplement for Dependents.
 3. Students with a Physical Disability:
 1. Notice of Registration and Fee Payment showing record of previous fee payments.
 2. Original and copy of Physical Disability Handbook.
 4. Children whose parent has a physical disability:
 1. Original and copy of Physical Disability Handbook.
 2. Original and copy of Complete Family Register or Family Register Transcript.
 3. Notice of Registration and Fee Payment showing record of previous fee payments.
 5. Students from low-income families:
 1. Original and copy of Low-income Registration. (Document must bear name of student.)
 2. Notice of Registration and Fee Payment showing record of previous fee payments.
 6. Aborigines:
 1. Original and copy of Complete Family Register or Family Register Transcript.
 2. Notice of Registration and Fee Payment showing record of previous fee payments.
